ADMISSION OF STUDENTS:

Access is open to persons minimum age of 25, who are in possession of the title of Superior Handball Coach (Level III of the Rinck Convention) with a minimum of 3 years from the date of issue of the abovementioned title.

FEES:

The fee is 1500 euros for each module. Total Master Coach cost 4500 €. Includes the accommodation in double room and meals. Participants will receive invoice from the Baltic Sea Master Coach financial control which is Finnish Handball Federation on the behalf of all the organizing federations.

REGISTRATION OF STUDENTS:

Students applying for admission to the Baltic Sea Master Coach 2025 Course, must register via kaj.kekki@finnhandball.net.

Registration period: 13.8.2024-30.10.2024. Language of the education is English.

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION MUST BE PROVIDED:

- Accreditation of being in possession of the title of Senior Coach (Level III)
- The date of issue of the Senior Coach (Level III) certificate must be issued at least 3 years ago
- Coaching career CV

The Baltic Sea Master Coach & European Handball Federation secretariat will communicate to the students the confirmation/denial of their application. The minimum number of students required for the course to be held is 16 and maximum 25 students. Equal allocation of six students for all organizing federations.

ATTENDANCE:

Students are required to attend all classes, as well as participate in practical classes. Therefore, in case of absenteeism due to exceptional circumstances, the student must present the situation to the Baltic Sea master Coach organizer (kaj.kekki@finnhandball.net) for its study and evaluation.

Please consult with the Baltic Sea Master Coach organizer (kaj.kekki@finnhandball.net) before the beginning of the course, if there is any problem in relation to class attendance, in order to establish the possibility or not of taking the course.
